

## CME DUE DATES AND LICENSE RENEWAL

Because the Board of Medicine has experienced a large increase in the number of physicians requesting an extension for CME reporting, it would like to remind physicians that CME must be completed by this Dec. 31, 2015, if you plan on renewing your license next year. Please remember: if you did not renew this year, you will be renewing next year, as licenses are now on a two year cycle.

Examples:

1. You renewed your license this year, effective July 1, 2015, for two years. You will renew again in the spring of 2017, but your CME reporting period for that renewal is Jan. 1, 2015-Dec. 31, 2016. All credits must be done **BEFORE** you renew.
2. You did not renew this year, but will renew next year (spring 2016). Your CME reporting period is Jan. 1, 2014-Dec. 31, 2015. Thus, you must fulfill your CME requirement by **THIS** Dec. 31.

Failure to fulfill your CME requirement before Dec. 31, 2015, may delay renewal of your license. For detailed information on when the Board will consider a request for a waiver of the deadline, please review administrative rule [Med 402.03](#).
